







FERRET REINTRODUCTION IN 2001





Future allocations in Mexico are needed:

- 1)Reinforce the BFF population in Mexico (allocation request)
- 2) Determine the BFF short-term survival after release
- 3) Determine home range and habitat use of released ferrets
- 4) Evaluate interactions with other species (predators, preys, and prairie dogs)
- 5) Apply the Sylvatic Plague Vaccine to reduce the disease risk on prairie dogs.

• Support from MEXICO and US authorities to obtain all necessary permits during 2016-17 (i.e. importation, exportation, capture).
