SHARED ENDANGERED SPECIES RECOVERY

THE TRILATERAL ENDORSEMENT HAS BEEN KEY FOR THE CONSERVATION SUCCESS OF THE FOLLOWING ENDANGERED SPECIES IN MÉXICO.

Mexican Wolf:

- 17 Wild individuals.



Bison:

- 100 Wild Individuals.



Golden Eagle:

- 36 Wild Individuals.



Jaguar:

- 317 active nests / 119 breeding pairs.

- 114 Community Committees (1,457 participants)

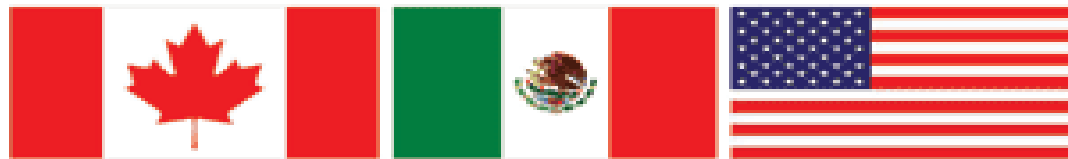
