

Update: Some definitions/advances

- This will be the first terrestrial wildlife refuge in Mexico
- ETJ: Semarnat /DGVS lead and coordinate team
- CONANP: Manage the Refuge
- Goal: Publish the “secretarial” agreement by September 2015. (It wasn’t possible).
- Since San Diego 2015:
 - SEMARNAT edit document,
 - TNC improve maps more focus on hydrological functionality
 - CONANP and CONABIO review new versión and Feedback. The team (TNC, Ajos –Bavispe Preserve and Cuenca Los Ojos) attend Feedback.
- The decree is scheduled by Dec. 2016. There is a “waiting lane” and Cajón Bonito is the 3rd one.




