- PROCER –
  - PROCER is the federal government instrument for conservation and recover species at risk
  - An example of collaboration for recover species with several stakeholders
  - Use proxy species (priority, surrogate...)
  - Increase effects of management and conservation measures
  - Including habitat and invasive species in natural protected areas (NPA)
  - PACE: 35 (December 2013)

    - Federal agencies
    - Research institutions
    - NGOs
    - Landowners
    - International agencies

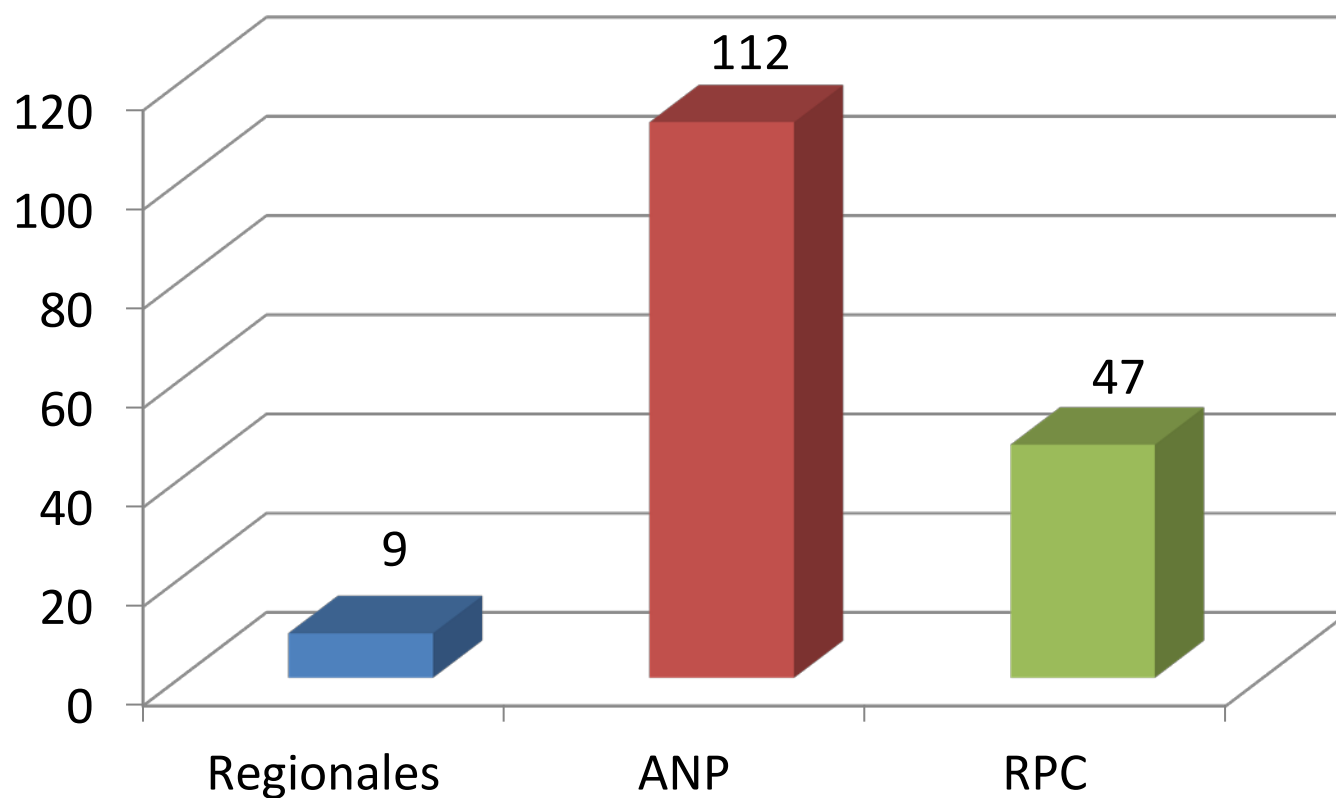

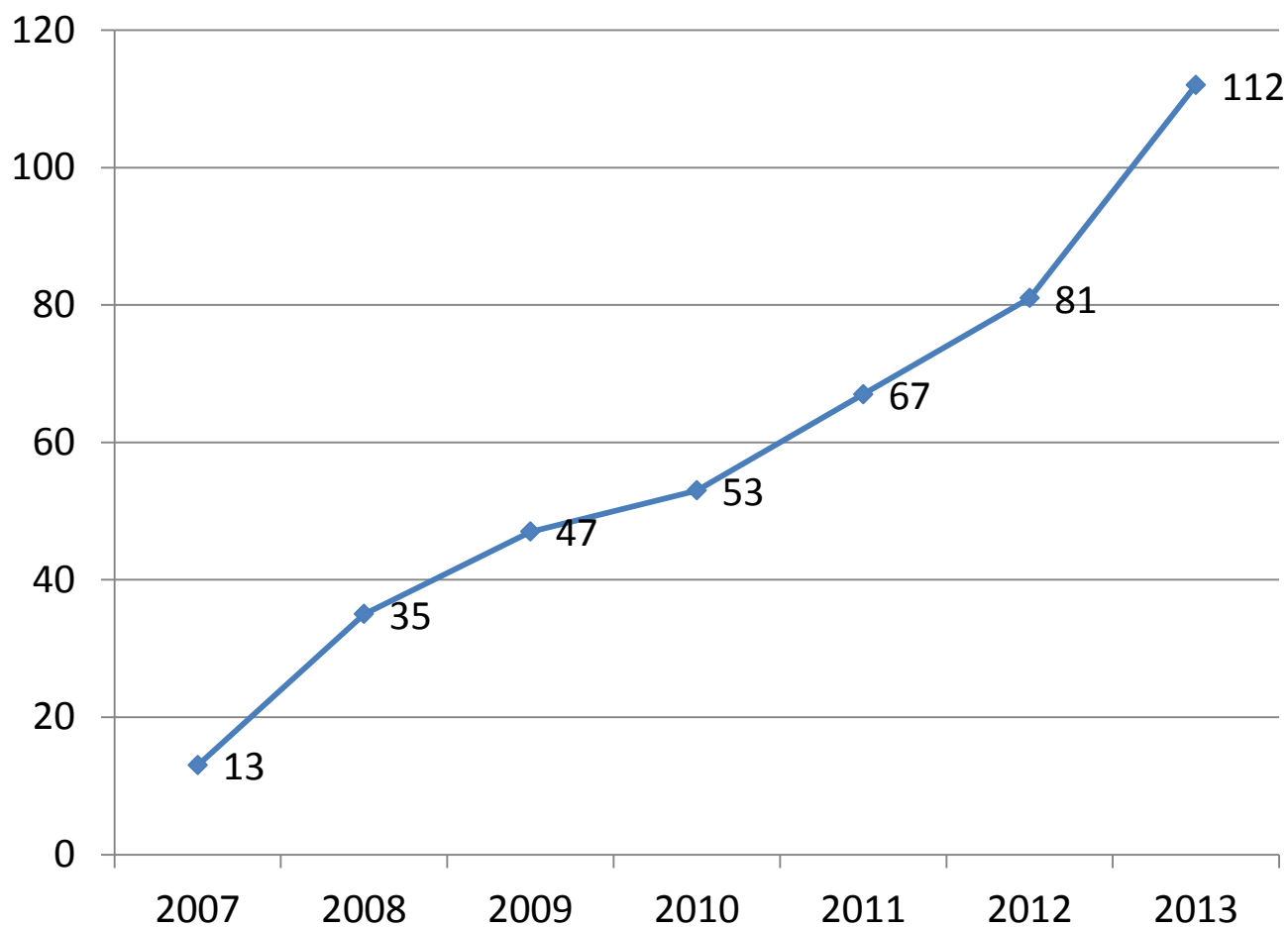

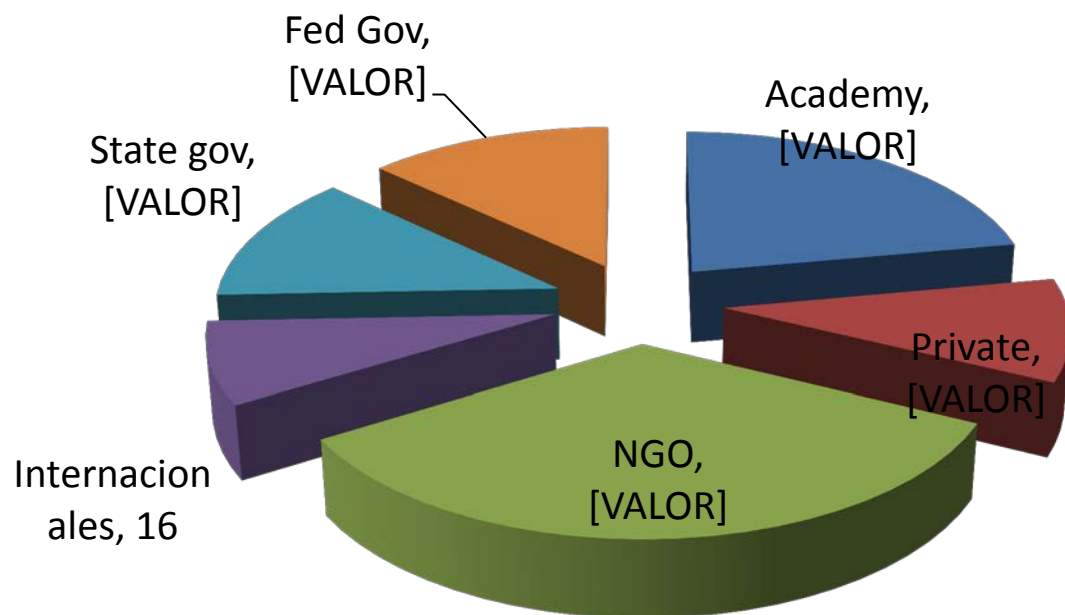


# Participation of NPA



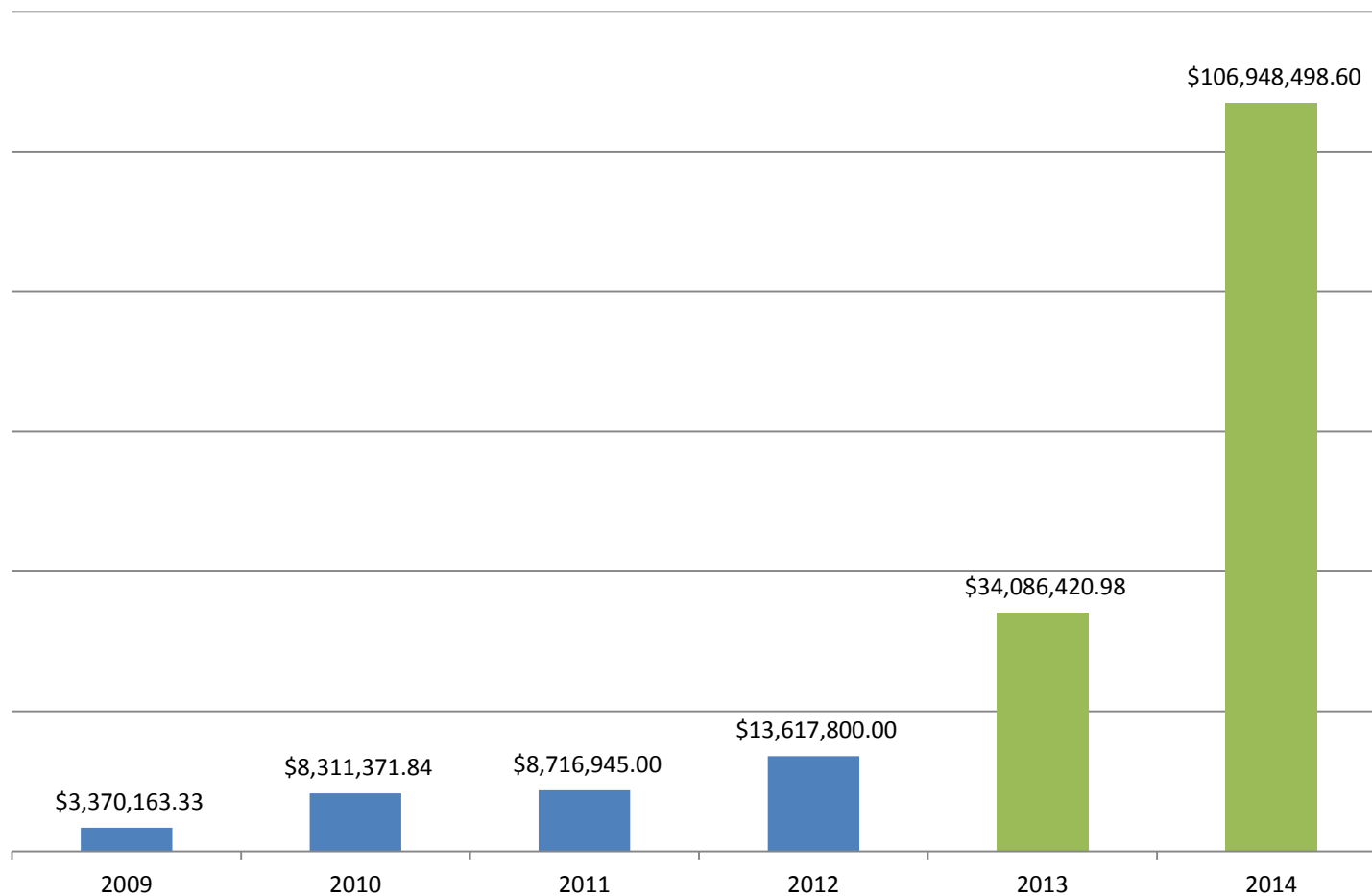

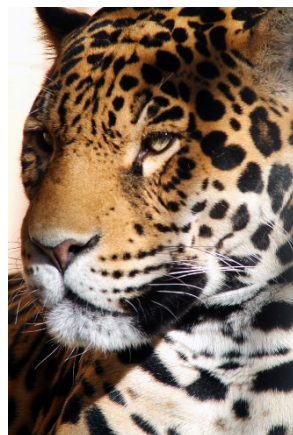
