


PROJECT BACKGROUND

In 2013, the USFWS approached CONANP with the idea of launching a midterm training program for Mexico's park rangers: *"Training for Conservation"*.

•Initially envisioned as a training program, today it is an **institutional** capacity building program for our Park Rangers.

•The USFWS triggered an institutional process to further recognize the value of park rangers and the need to further invest in professionalizing their work.



ONANP

GOAL: To train CONANP's 500 park rangers to gain training and expertise in critical protected area management issues.

INITIAL TARGET: 5 training workshops for 100 Park Rangers.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

- Due to the success of the first round of workshops and the enthusiasm of Park Rangers with this initiative, CONANP decided to allocate additional resources to enhance the program.
- Thanks to this synergy, 200 park rangers working in 106 NPAs, from 9 Regionals Directions of CONANP, have been trained during 8 training workshops and online sessions.

These workshops have created a space, where the Park Rangers across the country have the opportunity to share experiences, learn, and meet their peers.

- Ensuring coexistence among local communities and wildlife.
- Constantly updating online tools and topics with new emergent conservation challenges.
- Biggest Challenge: Heavy budget cuts in the Mexican federal government have resulted in less financial resources and reduction of personnel.
