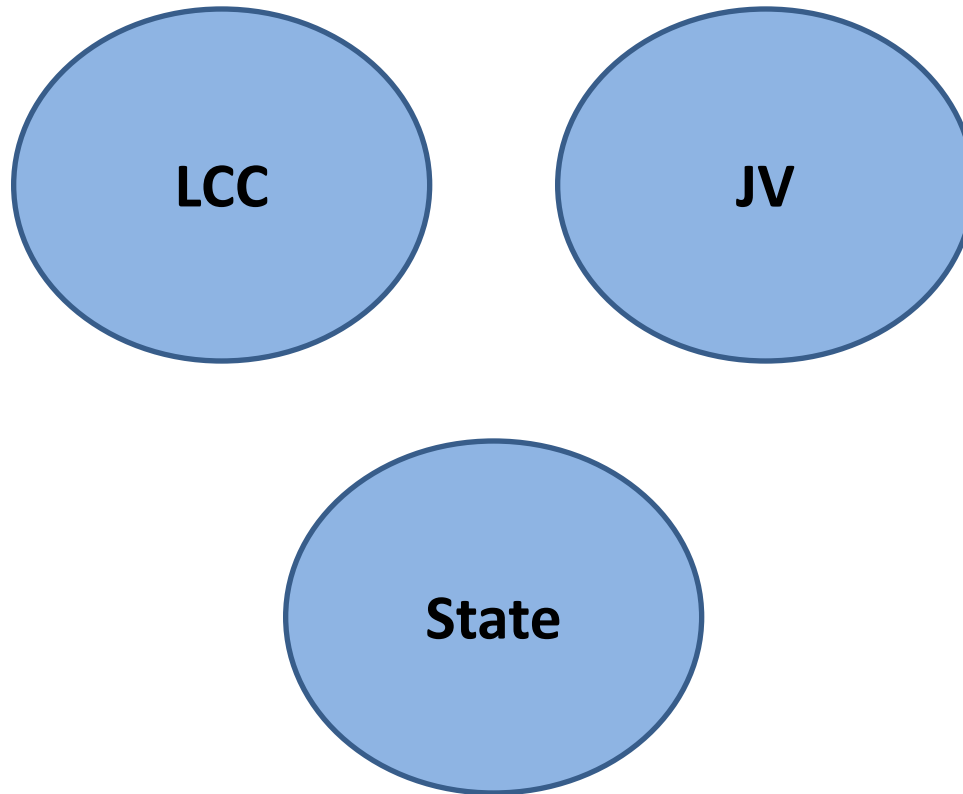


Why is Griffin Groups Needed?

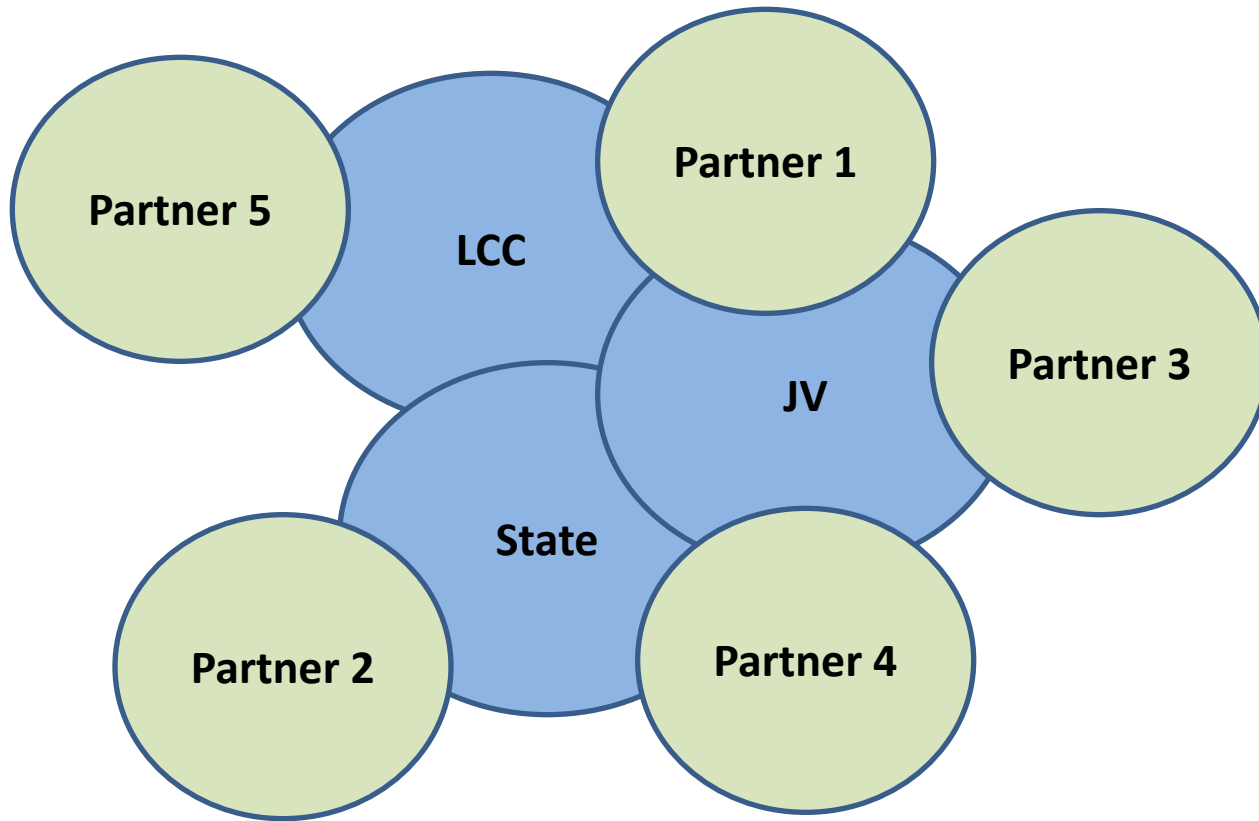

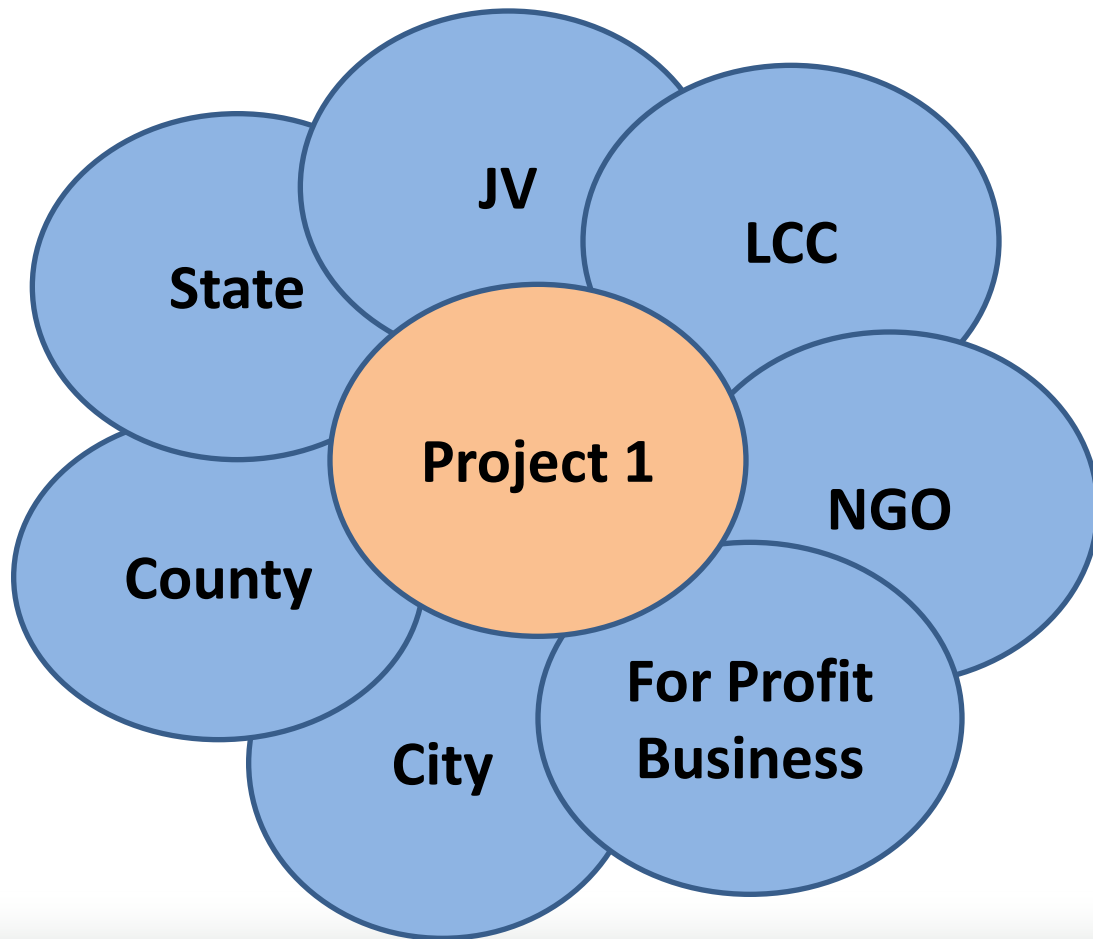

Griffin Groups (<https://griffingroups.com>) is a free-to-use online tool for connecting conservation knowledge and projects in a network of conservation communities. Using a single log in, members can join or start one or more groups to organize information and communications about conservation topics and customize how they receive group notifications. Group members can interact by email, archive their discussions within a group, and access a suite of collaboration tools. **Content** can be explored and searched within groups and across the site.

Griffin Groups revolves around the site member, their professional contacts, and the various groups that they start or join. Each member has a public profile and private **dashboard** that they can customize. While members can add content directly to their profile, most of the content on Griffin Groups is organized and accessible through customized groups. Members can **create as many public and private groups as they like** as long as they are compatible with the **Terms of Use**, including **copyright laws**. Every piece of content on the site also has visibility and editing permissions set by the person who first saved the content (see **Privacy**).

Connecting Conservation designed Griffin Groups to address the need for integrated knowledge transfer across disciplines, organizations, tools, and geographies in order to assist the transformation of natural resource conservation as a practice from independent to coordinated activities that address strategic public-private partnership goals.





Traditionally, the Southeast PIF working has been an aggregation of individuals representing various groups, and currently active members include individuals from state and federal agencies, universities, Joint Ventures, Non-Governmental Organizations, and other organizations. We also welcome participation by undergraduate and graduate students working on research projects related to bird conservation, management, and ecology.
