RESULT: Draft to entire Recovery Team by May 2015



GOAL: Convene a conference call or meeting to update partners of status and research on ocelots in Mexico, USA, etc.

RESULT: Contacted some parties, but call or meeting not yet scheduled



GOAL: Evaluate ocelot translocation protocols
RESULT: Bobcat translocated from SANWR to LANWR
